Théâtre jeunesse Les Gros Becs (TJGB) is dedicated to presenting theatre for young audiences in professional venues by companies from Quebec and abroad.

The programmed productions reflect the vibrant diversity of youth creation, offering a variety of high-quality theatrical forms to schools and families of the Capitale-Nationale and Chaudière-Appalaches regions.

TJGB is the only professional presenter in eastern Quebec dedicated to the performing arts for young people. Its presence in the Quebec City region is therefore crucial.

TJGB also contributes to the artistic initiation and literacy of young people aged 1 to 17 through cultural mediation activities, enabling them to develop their critical faculties and better appreciate the offered productions.

TJGB supports the development of the performing arts sector by encouraging regional creation, welcoming resident companies, and offering them support in the presentation of their work.

Finally, TJGB aims to provide access to the performing arts for all audiences, regardless of their physical, cultural, or socio-economic situation. Accessibility is at the heart of TJGB's philosophy.

#### A MAJOR TRANSFORMATION FOR THE CASERNE DALHOUSIE

Théâtre jeunesse Les Gros Becs is transforming the Caserne Dalhousie into a venue specifically dedicated to young people's theatre: La Caserne - scène jeune public.

The cultural identity of this Old Quebec building will be preserved as it becomes the permanent home of TJBG. This new venue will enable the organization to provide access to the performing arts for thousands of children, from early childhood to adolescence, thereby carrying out its mission.

La Caserne will feature a more spacious auditorium with a capacity of around 330, a foyer suitable for all audiences, a cozy reading area, a café, and a multi-purpose studio. A fresh look will be given to the building while preserving its emblematic heritage character. The target date for the inauguration is 2025.





#### WHY THE CASERNE?

A performing arts presenter's main asset is a functional theatre appropriate for its audience. We believe the right venue provides an inspiring experience and a long-lasting appreciation of the arts for each visitor. In addition to becoming the only infrastructure specifically designed for children and youth in the Capitale-Nationale region, the Caserne is designed

- Provide access to the performing arts for all audiences, regardless of their physical, cultural or socio-economic situation;
- Improve hospitality for the public and artists;
- Encourage development by increasing the seating capacity from 240 to 330;
- Support the theatrical community in its efforts to appeal to young audiences;
- Improve the organization's profitability and ensure its sustainability.

#### THE IMPORTANCE OF ACCESSIBILITY

TJGB is dedicated to providing access to the performing arts for all audiences, regardless of their physical, cultural or socio-economic situation. Accessibility is an essential part of TJGB's approach, whether for audiences, artists or employees. The relocation of TJGB to the Caserne Dalhousie will entail a variety of improvements to facilitate access for visitors with impaired mobility.

In addition, investments will be made in TJGB's Accessibility Fund, which will facilitate access to activities for young people from underprivileged sectors in the greater Quebec City area. This fund also supports the development of various theatrical initiation and education activities.

Finally, TJGB aims to support the emergence of performing arts for young audiences, a sector that often has limited expertise, resources, and creative equipment.

The goal for this funding is \$100,000.


